**What to Bring:**

It will be August and it is possible to have hot conditions so bring plenty of water for you and your dog(s). Also be prepared for inclement weather.

Other items to bring include: First aid kit, dog food, your dog's NAVHDA registry (to record score and have the judge sign), and a shot gun (optional for UPT and UT tests only). A folding chair and binoculars are also recommended

Keep in mind that a completed Test Entry is required prior to your being admitted to the test. If your entry is not complete, you will not be allowed to test and you may forfeit your test entry fee.

**A complete test entry includes:**

Dog's NAVHDA Registration Number  
Your NAVHDA Member Number (located on first line of your VHD magazine label)  
Clear copy of DNA certification (optional)  
Clear copy of hip dysplasia information (optional)  
Test entry fee  
Please make checks payable to the Hickory Run NAVHDA Chapter.

**Entrance Fee and Refund Policy**

The fee for the NA test is \$145. The fee for the UPT and UT is \$170. At least one owner of a co-owned dog AND the handler must be a NAVHDA member. One owner of the dog and the handler in the field BOTH (as opposed to "OR") must be a NAVHDA member.. Test entries will be taken on a first come first serve bases by the coordinator of testing. Test entry applications must be completed in entirety and accompanied by the appropriate funds in order to be accepted by the Test Secretary (NO EXCEPTIONS). All checks will be deposited upon receipt by the Treasurer.

If a handler decides to cancel a test entry, such request will be handled as follows: A refund equal to 80% of test fee will be given for any dog withdrawn more than 30 days before the test provided a FULLY PAID REPLACEMENT is found. NO REFUND will be made for withdrawal LESS THAN 30 DAYS PRIOR TO A TEST. ANY refunds for hardship withdrawals will be reviewed by the Executive Council on a case by case basis. In those cases, the council's refund decision will be final.

## **FAQ'S**

Q: Does my dog need to be registered with NAVHDA International?

A: Yes, if your dog does not have a registration number by the test date your spot will be given to another.

Q: Does the owner or the handler need to be registered with a local chapter or NAVHDA International.

A: Either the Handler or the Owner/co-owner needs to be registered with NAVHDA International.
